FFA News Reporting Contest

One news story must be in manuscript form with not more than three double spaced typewritten pages. One, and not more than one 5x7 color or black and white photograph must be mounted on one large sheet of black poster or matte board, preferably with protective covering for each.

Subject must relate to Agriculture Education and / or FFA.

Entries will be judged on basis of news value, readability and organization.

FFA Photography Contest

Entry must contain at least three, but not more than five, 5x7 color prints that were taken by the members. The series must be mounted on black poster or matte board, preferably with a protective covering over the prints.

Pictures on newsprint or those that have been mechanically altered will not be accepted. Subject must relate to the members supervised agricultural experience program (SAE) or the FFA activities within their local chapter.

Entries will be judged on subject matter, effectiveness, photo quality and composition.
