Leadership Greater Enid is a leadership program established in 1990. It selects, challenges, develops and educates citizens in the greater Enid area who have demonstrated an interest in local issues. The vision of Leadership Greater Enid is inspiring today's leaders for tomorrow, preparing tomorrow's leaders for today. The mission of LGE is to foster civic engagement, build professional relationships and engage leaders to inspire a collective purpose in our community. The program is designed to be a series of issue-oriented forums and experiences, which are based on the belief that knowledge is a key element and prime motivator of leadership.

Leadership Greater Enid is open to all interested residents in the Greater Enid area and does not discriminate on the basis of age, sex, race, religion, or national origin. Participants are selected on ability, demonstrated interest in their community, and insight for effective leadership. The application process is to ensure a class that consists of members from diverse backgrounds and experiences. The class will be limited to a maximum of 20 members.

COMMITMENT

The course consists of a mandatory two-day orientation and team building retreat, seven day sessions, a two-day/overnight law and government session and an evening graduation ceremony. Class members will be required to serve Ex Officio on a Board of their choice during the year of the program (to be determined by Wednesday, September 11, 2019), AND complete a class community service project. As with all worthwhile endeavors, this program requires a definite commitment of time on the part of each participant. Spouses are not included in meetings or overnight sessions, but they are welcome to attend the orientation social event and graduation program.

Attendance is **mandatory** for successful completion of the program and will be closely monitored. **Absence from more than one full session or partial sessions may make the participant ineligible for graduation.** Locations for each session will be emailed to you at least one week before the session. All applications must be received no later than 5:00pm on Monday, July 15, 2019 to leadershipgreaterenid@gmail.com. Each candidate may be asked to interview for the class during the week of July 22. Various times and dates will be given in an effort to accommodate everyone's schedule. You will be notified of the Selection Committee's decision by July 29, 2019, by email. Tuition is due and payable prior to Sept. 11, 2019, unless extended terms of payment for tuition have been approved.

TUITION

Tuition for the program is \$600.00, which covers all program costs, materials, and meals. Partial financial assistance and extended terms are available on a limited basis. Please email leadershipgreaterenid@gmail.com to request a scholarship application. Requests for financial assistance will be considered on the basis of *demonstrated* need. Additional information may be required. Financial information will be held in confidence. Leadership Greater Enid firmly believes in supporting up and coming leaders in the Enid community.

AGREEMENT

I understand:

- * That it is **mandatory** to attend all Leadership Greater Enid sessions, and absence from more than one session may make me ineligible to graduate.
- * That the two-day orientation/team building retreat is mandatory - **no exceptions**.

- * That participation in a group community service project is **mandatory** and will require time outside of regular sessions.
